Objective:

The objective of the comprehensive feedback mechanism is to achieve quality enhancement and to correctly determine the impact of all the efforts taken by the institution at all levels on the various stakeholders. The institution wants the benefits to reach all the stakeholders. This feedback is collected and trends generated through statistical analysis. Based on the inputs of the stakeholders, further action is taken by the feedback committee.

Methodology:

- Feedback on curriculum is collected from students by circulating the Feedback Forms. It is collected and to IQAC for further analysis. Further suggestions are incorporated by the college.
- Alumni Feedback is collected during alumni meeting. The filled forms are sent to the committee for analysis.
- Feedback is collected from teachers by circulating the feedback forms. Subsequent action of analysis will be undertaken by the committee.
- Employer Feedback is collected in person and suitable action will be initiated
- Feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the stakeholders and further action to be taken is discussed with the departments and the authorities.

The data is compiled and analyzed. It is given for deliberation to the departments,

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INTRODUCTION:


SECAB's A. R. S. Inamdar Arts, Science and Commerce College for situated in Vijayapur. It is affiliated to Karnataka State Akkamahadevi Women's University, Vijayapur. The college offers various courses like B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com at Under Graduation level and M.A. in English at Post-Graduation level. Presently, over 500 students are studying in college. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College has continuously been working on quality improvement and the betterment of student learning experiences. In order to analyze the lag areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from various stakeholders have been received. This report focuses on the feedback of students on Syllabus and Teachers.

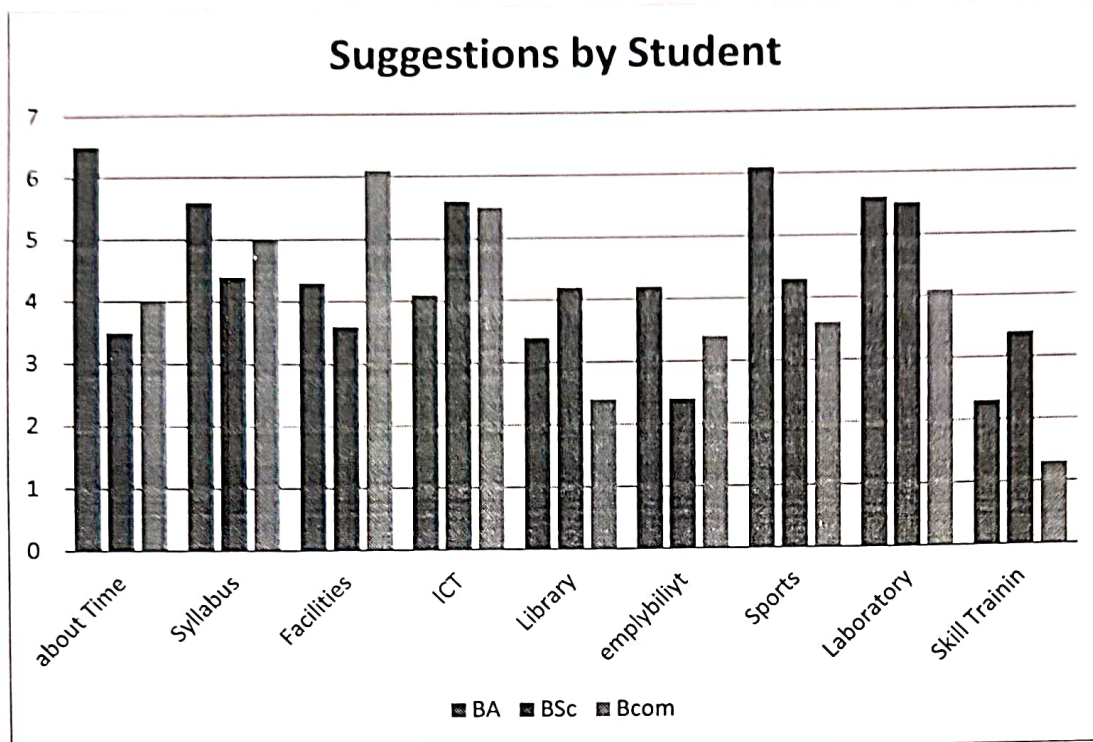
DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

An effort was made to receive feedback from all students of the college. For this purpose, a format was created on academic aspects. A total of 100 responses have been received on Syllabus and teachers from the students. In order to arrive to comprehensive results, useful statistical tools like percentage, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, graphs have been used.

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Feedback was received from 100 students from all the three programs Arts, Science and Commerce. With reference to first question 86% of the students were satisfied with the timing of the college and the Time-Table. 14% of students said that they need change both in Timing of the college as well as Time-Table.

With reference to second question 85% of students said that they are satisfied with the present syllabus and need no change. 15% of students suggested that the syllabus should be updated. With reference to the third question 88% of students were satisfied with the available facilities. 12% of students suggested for improvement in the said facilities. With reference to the fourth question 85% of students were satisfied with the usage of ICT facilities. 15% of students suggested for the need of improvement in ICT facilities. With reference to fifth question 90% of students were satisfied with the facilities available in the college library. 10% of students suggested for the improvement of library facilities. With reference to sixth question 90% of students said that the present three year course helps them to get employment. 10% of students suggested that they need training for competitive exams which will help them to seek employment. With reference to seventh question 88% of students were satisfied regarding sports facilities available in the college. 12% of students suggested that a regular physical director or sports teacher is needed to train them in different sports so that they can compete with students of other colleges. With reference to eighth question 85% of students were satisfied with the facilities available in the laboratories. 15% of students suggested for the increase of space in the present laboratories besides sides developing: separate laboratories in Physics and Chemistry on the basis of subjects such as organic, Inorganic and Physical


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


laboratories. Similarly in Physics subject. Suggestion was also given for improving more facilities in the laboratories with equipment's. And with reference to ninth question 93% of students were satisfied with the present vocational and skill based training to students. 7% of students suggested that a few more such training courses are necessary.

Therefore it was decided to continue the present timings of the college.

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9	What vocational training/skill based education you require along with graduation? Give suggestions	Add-on and Value added courses have been started.
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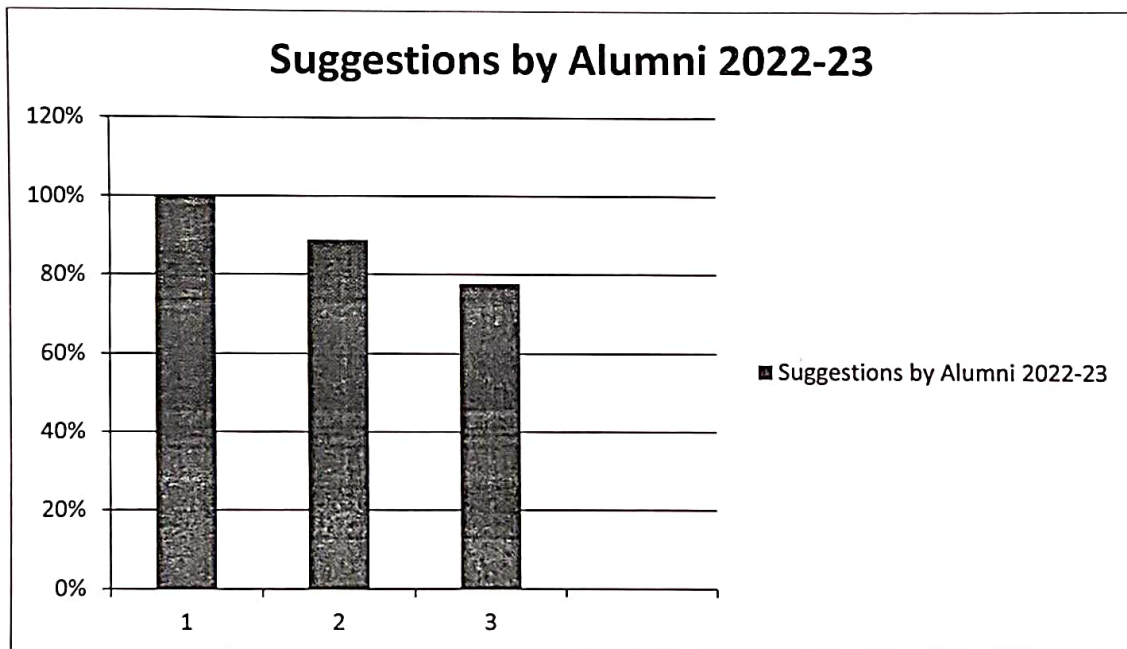

the college timings. And 77.7% of students responded to the third question and requested for better facilities in the hostel.

- d. Teachers


During the academic year of 2022-23, 15 responses were obtained. Out of these 08 responses belong to Assistant teachers working in primary and high schools, 02 responses from lecturers working in Universities and one response from Vijayapur D.C.C Bank and one response from P.U.C College working as lecturer.


These responses have been scrutinized the analysis is as shown below.

1. A few of the respondents have said that the performance of the employers working in their institutions has been either good or satisfactory.
2. A few of the respondents have said that the curriculum followed by employers is relevant for employability.
3. A few of the respondents have said that the curriculum has created an innovative thinking. However a couple of them suggested for updating of the curriculum and it should be more relevant to fulfill the needs of the society.
4. However, bring the above observations, the performance of the employee and the relevance of the curriculum was appreciated.

Action Taken Report

The feedback analysis was discussed in the presence of the Principal and the faculty members on 15/02/2023 at 3:30 pm. The Principal called out the teachers and asked them to suggest the Board of Studies of the University to revamp the respective subject syllabi to fulfill the needs of the society and to develop the employability ability of the students.

Feedback of Teacher: Analysis

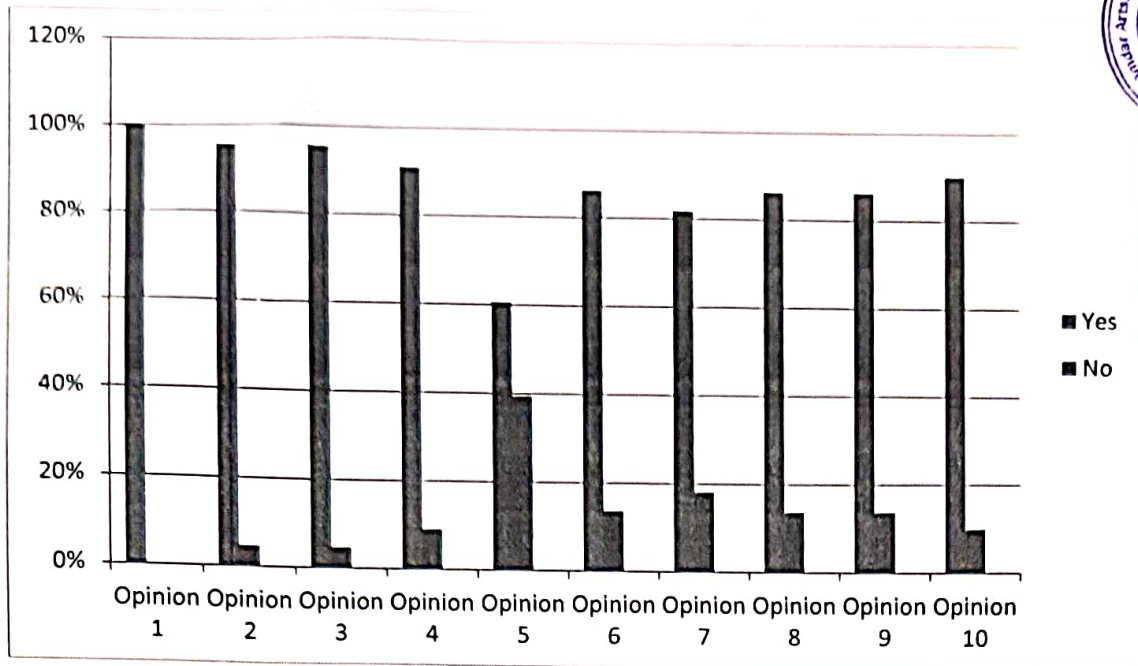
The college is affiliated to the Karnataka State Women's University, Vijayapur and follows the prescribed curriculum. Still feedback on curriculum is taken by the respective subject teachers on the parameters fixed regarding suggestions on improvement of the syllabus. We have received 22 teachers feedback on the curriculum and analyzed.

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Teacher's feedback which involves accurate appraisal of the effectiveness of teaching, its strength and areas that need development and revision of curricular plays a vital role in the development of the institution. Teachers had given feedback about the curriculum. There were 22 respondents.

1. 100% of teachers agreed that curriculum is updated from time to time.
2. 95.4% of teachers say that recent advances are covered in the syllabus and 4.5% disagree.
3. 95.4% of teachers agree that the time allotted to cover the syllabus is sufficient and 4.5% disagree.
4. 95.4% of teachers agree that the curriculum develops competency among the students and 4.5% disagree.
5. 81.8% of teachers agree that the curriculum encourages research among the students and 18.1% disagree.
6. 86.3% of teachers agree that the curriculum enhances the scope for skill development among the students and 13.6% disagree.
7. 81.8% of teachers agree that the course content provides possibility for employment and 18.1% disagree.
8. 86.3% of teachers agree that the curriculum addresses issues like gender, environment,
9. sustainability, human values and professional ethics and 13.6% disagree.
9. 86.3% of teachers agree that there is enough freedom to suggest modifications in the curriculum and 13.6% disagree.
10. 90.9% of teachers agree that there the POS, PSO and COs of the syllabi are well defined and 9.9% disagree.


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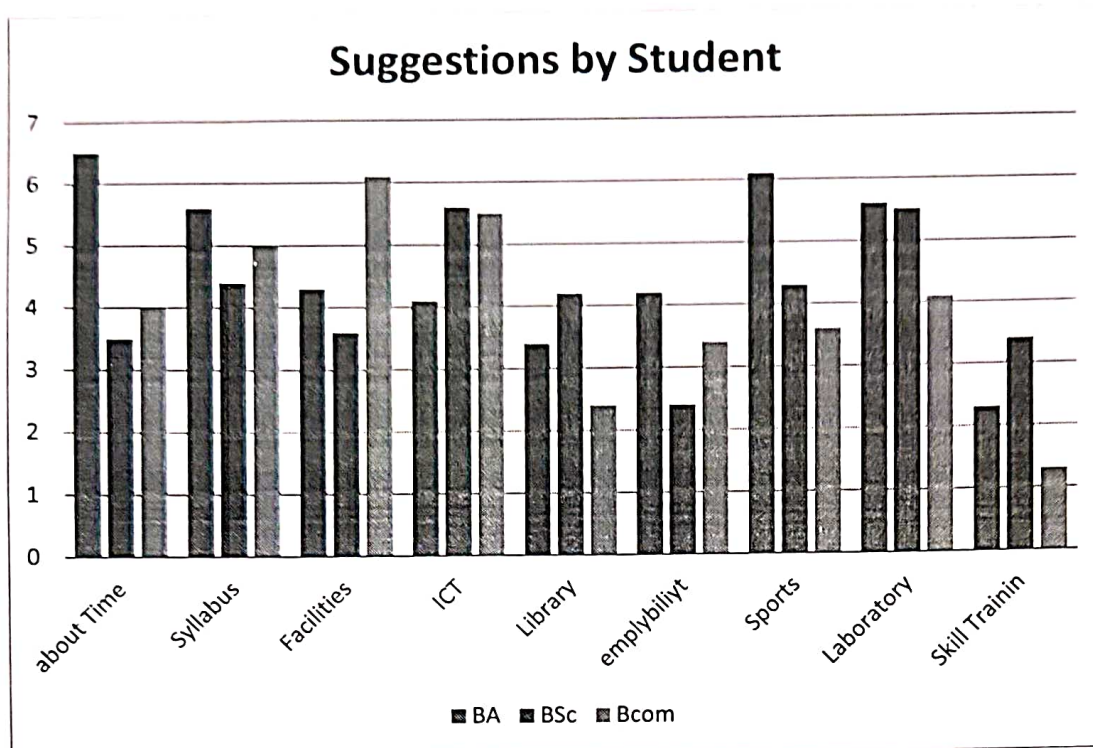
ACTION TAKEN ON THE FEEDBACK FROM TEACHERS 2022-23

The feedback received from the faculty was brought to the notice of the principal. The present feedback had a non-agreement on the current curriculum in the following aspects. 39.1% of teachers felt that the curriculum does not offer for skill development and research. 13.6% felt that the degree certificate does not prepare the student for employability. Also same number of teachers did not agree that there is freedom for change in the curriculum. 9.9% teachers felt that recent advances are not included in the curriculum.

The Principal advocated that those teachers who attend BOS as members should converse on this point in the BOS meeting. They have been debated and have resulted in some upgrading and modification of the syllabus.



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
