 - Bridge Course was organised for the fresher's for 15 days from 16/6/2017 and 225 students were benefited from this.


- Career guidance workshop was organised through Career Guidance Cell of the college and 85 students participated in the workshop.

Annual Report- 2016-17

The IQAC of Secab ARS Inamdar Arts Science and Commerce College for Women, has been functioning successfully since its inception. With a focus on academic excellence to ensure quality in all operations, the core team of IQAC designed the plan at the beginning of the academic year towards the Quality enhancement.

This report details the activities/events carried out by the IQAC in accordance with the plan of action that had been outlined for the academic year 2016-17, which included all activities of the college which begin with the preparation of Calendar of Events in coordination with the affiliated University and the Examination committee of the college.

- ❖ To promote quality culture a four day program was organized where concentration was laid on to increase of practical exposure to students for all subjects, which started on 13/7/2016.
- ❖ A 3 day program was organized to strengthen activities on social responsibility by visiting the slums. This is to care for their health, literacy, and empowerment.
- ❖ Following activities were taken up by the IQAC to enrich teaching learning by field visits:
 1. The students of the Dept of Home science and Zoology visited to a model Kitchen garden, Vermi-culture unit at Agriculture University, Vijayapur, Silk worm rearing unit, Local Jute Industry, old age home, Dietetics dept at Govt Hospital, and Food Industry.
 2. One week soft skill course was conducted for 6th semester students. The subjects covered were, Phonetics, Power Point Presentation and Interview skills.
- ❖ With reference to certificate course: One batch of students completed Basic Electronic course which began from 10/4/17 and three batch of students completed Cashbook writing course which began from 10/10/17; 16/2/17 and 22/3/17.
- ❖ With reference to ICT the college enabled 8 ICT classrooms and 2 smart classrooms with the help of which almost all teachers started using ICT for effective teaching and learning.
- ❖ 23 research articles were published by the faculty members of the dept of English, Physics, Chemistry, Urdu, Lib Science, Sanskrit, Arabic, Political Science and Sociology.


- ❖ The faculty of Lib Science, Arabic, Urdu and Sanskrit published 8 research articles in conference proceedings.
- ❖ 31 faculty members of the college participated in Local, national and international, Seminars/Conferences and workshops and presented 21 papers.
- ❖ With reference to extension and outreach programs following programs were organized:
 1. Rain Water Harvesting program was organized with District Training Institute Vijayapur. 30 students and a faculty member participated in the program.
 2. Environmental Day program was organized by Dept of Geography on the college campus. 60 students and 9 teachers participated in the program.
 3. Faculty Development Program was organized with District Training Institute Vijayapur. One faculty member and 40 students participated in the program.
- ❖ With reference to extension activities, following activities were conducted:
 1. Swach Bharath Abhiyan Program was organised with RUDSET Vijayapur, 8 faculty members and 250 students of the college participated in the program.
 2. AIDS awareness program was organised in coordination with NSS and Red Cross, 10 faculty members and 240 students participated in the program.
 3. The Dept of Geography organised tree plantation program. 8 faculty members of the college and 60 students participated in the program.
- ❖ With reference to Collaborative activities for research, faculty exchange, student exchange during the year following activities were conducted:
 1. The college provided lab facilities to the students of B. D. E. Society's degree college, Vijayapur.
 2. Dept of Urdu organised workshop on 'Spoken Urdu' program to refine the students' verbal communication skills.
 3. Student Exchange program was taken up by the college where students of B. D. E. society's degree college participated in the activity.
 4. Some of the teachers of the college were visited for guest lecture at SIET, RUDSET etc.


- ❖ Three MoUs were signed by the college with RUDSET (19/1/17), Vijayapur, B. D. E. society's degree college, Vijayapur (15/7/16) and Chetna College, Vijayapur (23/2/17). 188 students were benefited by this.
- ❖ In this academic year the library added 357 text books and 241 reference books.
- ❖ In technology up-gradation 33 computers were adding to the existing 50 computers.
- ❖ Under various scholarship schemes 222 students of the college were benefited with total amount of Rs 5,00,389/-
- ❖ With reference to capability enhancement and development schemes such as Soft skill development, Remedial coaching, Language lab, Bridge courses, Yoga, Meditation, Personal Counselling and Mentoring etc., Following activities were conducted:
 1. Bridge Course for Fresher's began from 5/7/2016 and 197 students took benefit of the program.
 2. Mentoring of 571 students began from 1/8/2016.
 3. Meditation t NSS camp Pehalwan galli, Vijayapur was organised on 25/3/2017 and 100 students participated in the program.
 4. Dept of Psychology, Education and Home Science 27 students were benefited in Personal counselling.
- ❖ With reference to guidance for competitive examinations and career counselling offered by the institution during the year 75 students were benefited by the career guidance workshop. 10 students cleared competitive exams and 8 were employed.
- ❖ With reference to campus placement, 25 students participated in the on campus interviews conducted by the Secab Association and 20 students participated off campus interview conducted by St. Joseph School, Aishwarya Jute Bags and Bharti Vidya Vardhak Sangh, Vijayapur and 9 students got placement.
- ❖ Besides, participating in Sports and Cultural activities organised by the college, 8 of the students bagged awards and prizes at national level.
- ❖ The college Alumni was enrolled with 156 new members who contributed Rs 75860/-
- ❖ Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution:
 1. With reference to curriculum development the last years initiatives in curricular development was analyzed, it was found to be very effective in making the students understand the importance of learning from practical experience they gain due to visits. The same thing is continued this year also.

2. With reference to teaching and learning, teaching system were strengthened by problem based learning methods. This is apart from other modes of teaching like participatory learning, active learning etc. For instance teaching of mathematics, physics and chemistry this system proved to be quite effective.
 3. With references to library, during the year 2016/17, 10620 books, 12719 reference books, 31 journals, 450 e books downloaded, 3 years e-question papers 100 research articles were added.
- ❖ Workshop on AAA was conducted on 5/3/17 in which 40 teaching and 6 non-teaching participated in the program.
 - ❖ AAA audit was conducted by the LIC of the Affiliating University.
 - ❖ As quality initiative by the IQAC to UGC National Seminars were organised:
 1. UGC sponsored two day National Seminar in English (Indian Women Writing in English) was organised (23/9/16 to 24/9/16) 300 delegates participated in the program.
 2. UGC sponsored one day National Seminar in Sociology (Female Foeticide) was organised (23/9/16) 100 delegates participated in the program.
 - ❖ With reference to gender equity following programs were organised:
 1. A rally was organised in protest against the existing laws of rape victims on 9/2/17 and 10/2/17 in which 350 students of the college participated.
 2. A program of Legal awareness on reproductive rights for women was organised on 25/2/17 and 26/2/17 in which 300 students of the college participated.
 3. On the occasion of International Women's Day a special lecture was organised on the topic 'Women Empowerment' on 8/3/17 and 350 students of the college were participated in the program.
 - ❖ With reference to Inclusion and Situatedness following activities were organised:
 1. The Dept of History organised a one day visit to historical monuments on 25/8/16 for enrichment of students and understanding of local history.
 2. The Dept of Psychology organised a one day visit to Dept of Psychiatry at BLDE Medical College Vijayapur, on 15/9/16 to give exposure to various aspects of psychiatric disorders thus correlated with what has been done in the classrooms.
 3. The Dept of Home Science organised one day program on 20/1/17 to create awareness on nutrition in women and children in slums, and help the needy to improve their health with greater understanding of nutrition.

4. The Dept of Home Science organised one day program on 28/3/17 to identify working skills amongst women in slums who have achieved self-employment.

❖ Nearly 359 students of the college received financial assistance through various Government schemes such as:



All activities of the college begin with the preparation of Calendar of Events in coordination with the affiliated University and the Examination committee of the college.


- ❖ The Academic year begin with Bridge course in English for the fresher's of BA, BSC and Bcom. (1-7-2014 to 15-7-2014)

- ❖ The subject teachers and students of the Department of Mathematics, Science, Kannada and Urdu visited the primary schools of the sister institution to help to improve the standard of learning in the above subjects.
- ❖ The Commerce stream of V and VI semester was continued.
- ❖ To strengthening e-learning OPAC, INFLIBNET was introduced.
- ❖ Focusing on value addition and Home management skill, Basic skill for girls was started on 18-08-2014.


- ❖ Students' mentoring system was continued with 20-24 students to each mentor were allotted for addressing students' problems.
- ❖ Many a number of teachers not only attended seminars and conferences, but also presented and published research papers in journals and Proceedings.
- ❖ The Department of Sociology, NSS and Lions Club in Coordination with the Dept of Home Science organised Blood Donation Camp in the college.
