

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COLLEGE FOR THE YEAR 2016-17

Hon Chief Guest of this Function Dr. P.A Inamdar Sahab, Respected President Janab Shamshuddin Punekar Saheb, Respected Chairman Governing Council of our College Janab Riyaz Farooqui Saheb, congregated members of the Management , Different heads of institution parent's invitees, Rank Holders of our College learned Colleagues and my dear Students.

Ours College is run by a prestigious educational organization Called "**SECAB**". With a view to provide Education and vocation to women an Association Called "Socio Economic and Cultural Association of Bijapur" (SECAB) was organized in the year 1969. The founder, an Ernest Civil Engineer Janab Shamshuddin Abdullah Punekar taking the assistance of his close friends put the vision of an Institution into a reality. With a small beginning of just a section of clothing & embroidery and kinder garden, today there are nearly 22 Institutions including Architecture Engineering, Professional Colleges and a Medical College of Unani System running effectively.

Now I want to give a brief introduction of each institution

Clothing & Embroidery was the first effort of 1969 which is still rendering service to the Minority and other backward Women in the city. SECAB kinder Garden with the strength of mere 17 students made a bold beginning in a rented building in the city. It was started on 1st august 1969. 14 of these 17 children remained with us to take their SSLC certificate in the year 1980.

In 1970 Three Institutions simultaneously came into being viz.,

- SECAB English Medium Primary School,
- Central Hindi School- Hindi Medium
- SECAB Secondary School – Hindi Medium.

So-far more than 10,000 boys and girls are receiving Education in these schools, and many of them are well placed in life and form crux of the new generation of the city. Many have gone abroad. The school has kept up high standard of Education. In 1972 SECAB Pre - University College for Women was started with the aim giving good quality education at this stage. This college is growing from strength to strength. Seven hundred girls are studying at plus two at this college. The college has maintained a consistently a high standard. Many girls secured admission to medical colleges on merit and are now practicing physicians and surgeons. And many more girls are working as Engineers. An exclusive and fully fledged women's college came into existence in the year 1974. The college is named after late Janab Abdul Razzaq. S. Inamdar Saheb of Pune the father of our Chief Guest P. A. Inamdar Sahab (in the year 1991), it is our College. A polytechnic with Architecture as the main branch was established in the year 1983. The Institution was named after the great architect "Malik Sandal" who was a renowned architect of the Adil Shahi's of 16th century. Now this College has the strength of one thousand students with 55 teaching staff.

In 1984 it was thought that combining boys and girls at plus two stages was not proper and therefore an exclusive boy's college was started in the year 1984. This college is rendering good service to boys who desire to go ahead. Many students of this college have been securing medical, engineering seats on merit. Every year students secure 100 out of hundred in Maths , Physics, Chemistry & Statistic subjects. At present it has the strength of 500 students with 25 teaching staff. In 1985 four Urdu medium high schools and one Kannada medium school simultaneously came into being viz.,

Tahirunnisa High School, Bijapur
Modern High School, Bijapur (Kannada Medium)
Malik Sandal High School, Mudhol Town.
SECAB Anjuman High School Kolhar Town.

In 1991 the Architecture course of the polytechnic was upgraded into full fledged college of Architecture and was also named after the great “Malik Sandal” the architect who created the Ibrahim Rouza. Now it has the strength of 115 students and 15 teaching faculty. This college is trying its best to produce Capabale architects Bijapur. In 1999 the management finally started a much awaited Unani Medical college named after “Hakim Luqman”. With the following objectives

1. Preparing students both in Unani and Allopathic system of medicine.
2. Providing to the people of Bijapur a reliable hospital where appropriate and effective medicine at affordable cost is provided.

From the academic year 2014 P. G. courses in Unani System have been started. At present it has the total strength of 300 students and 50 teaching staff.

In the year 2002 the Association has started an Engineering College by name “SECAB Institute of Engineering and Technology”, with four branches viz., Electronics and Communication, Computer Science, Information Technology Civil Engineering and Electrical and Electronics . This Institution is recognized by all India Council of Technical Education (**AICTE**) and affiliated to Visveswaraiah Technological University (**VTU**) Belgaum, Karnataka. This college also offers Post Graduate Courses Viz M.B.A, M. Tech (Civil) M.Tech (Mech) & M. Tech (Comp. Sci), at present more than 2000 students from different states of India are studying in this college.

SECAB made a beginning at Bangalore by starting Urdu cum English medium school from first to seventh standard and a P. U College are functioning since June 1998.

Now SECAB Association is running institution from K.G. to P.G.

Now I will come to introduce our College with a brief report of achievements and activities conducted during this academic year 2016-17.

On this 41st annual day of this College we are standing here to celebrate more than four decades of successful functioning of this College. This Academic year I am very proud to say, is going to add more glory and color to the long and successful journey of this College, we have new fathers to beautify our caps. Yes, this year also we have **three more ranks** to the University and consecutively for the third time we are bagging **first rank** to the University. **Miss Vijaya laxmi Hiremeath** has secured the **first rank** to Karnataka State Women University and **Miss Mahananda Shegunashi** has got the **second rank**, and I would like to remind here that our College had been bestowed with first ranks in 2014, 2015 and 2016 also, and in the Science stream also our students **Miss. Shaheen Kousar** has scored **tenth rank** to the University. I would very proudly extend my congratulations to these achievers and I would also complement and appreciate the excellent guidance and dedication shown by our learned teaching staff who have not spared any efforts in channelising the capacities of our rank holders. Not only these ranks but our overall results of our College every year and also this year is are not only remarkable but also we are setting new records in all three streams of Arts, Science and Commerce. Our students have been proving their worth and mettle not only at undergraduate level but even at Post Graduate levels to

substantiate this claim, out of five ranks declared for M.A this year, by Karnataka State Women University, first four ranks have been bagged by our students, and those talents are

1. Miss. Suman Patil
2. Miss. Tarana Khudasi
3. Miss. Tarannum Patel
4. Miss. Suman Lambu

Even going further our students are successfully perusing their higher studies with PhD, M.Phil and even post doctoral research. Even in competitive examinations, and carrier advancements and placements our students are doing extremely well and upholding the excellent lineage of the College for all these constant achievements and setting of a high standard. I should remember with thanks the great academic concern and vigilance of our SECAB Management who constantly guiding us and supporting us. At this juncture I would also thankfully acknowledge the support and constructive and corrective guidance of all the parents and especially the parents council headed by Mr. Bilagipeer and others who always ensure that we tread in the right path. I thank them al Ladies and Gentlemen, we have a strong force of very enthusiastic alumni of this College, who proudly participate in the meetings and give constructive ideas to improve the working mode of the College and they also contribute for improving the infrastructural facilities of the College.

In the infrastructural side we have another major breakthrough, we have finished the construction of the third floor, by which we have been able to provide sufficient and adequate accommodation For the smooth running of the College. For this I thank our management for helping us generously for taking up this construction work. I also thank our teaching staff for making contribution for this noble cause. In the coming years we hope to take up more work to better the facilities to the students. We are planning to equipp the building with an elevator to facilitate all students particularly physically challenged students. This year of 2016-17 is again a milestone in the history of this College, because this year we have entered into the Galaxy of Post Graduate studies, and we have launched a P.G course i.e. M.A in English literature and 15 students are already perusing their studies in M.A II Semester. For this I thank our management for backing us in this endeavor and must congratulate our faculty of English department Prof. M. T. Kotnis, Prof. C. L. Patil and Miss Shilpa Patil for taking up a great initiative in establishing and running the course successfully.

Academic growth is not mear teaching learning, examinations and results, it is certainly our ability to take the learning above the limits of routine teaching and learning to the heights of exposure of advanced knowledge in research areas, yes we have achieved this goal by organizing some National and State Level Seminars in English, History and Sociology. These seminars have explored into some unexplored areas of academic excellence and acclaimed a great appreciation in the academic circles. I thank and complement the staff and students of these departments for organizing these seminars in an appreciable way. Our students are excellent not only in curricular but also in co-curricular activities.

This year particularly, the co-curricular activities conducted under the chairmanship of Dr. S. M. Hudli. Our students actively participated in many cultural events like elocutions, debates, Singing, Rangoli, Painting, Fancy dress, Essay writing and other items very actively and exhibited their talents. They have won Prizes not only at College and Inter-Collegiate levels but also at District and University

level contests. Especially youth week was observed during which several activities and competitions were held to bring out the hidden talents. The highlights of the achievements were :

Since last year we have been bringing out News letter Called “HORIZON”, and this news letter covers all major achievements and activities of the College very effectively in a typical journalistic style. Today on this occasion we are publishing 2nd and 3rd editions and for this endeavor I thank and appreciate the creativity and hard work of executive editor Prof. H. K. Yadahalli and the editorial board— Prof. M. T. Kotnis, Prof C. L. Patil and Prof. M. S. Metri. Our College has a very efficient Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) which is monitoring and channelising all the activities of the College for this I thank Prof. C. L. Patil, the IQAC Co-ordinator and his team for their dedicated work. On this occasion I will be failing in my duties if I do not mention the name of Prof. Hasan Quadri from Department of Hindi, in addition to his regular teaching work he has taken up the complete responsibility of organizing and supervising the construction work in the campus. So for this cause we have two N.S.S Units each consisting of one hundred volunteers. Those two units are headed by Prof. M. T. Kotnis and Prof. Hasan Khadri. Under their leadership our N.S.S volunteers have undertaken several social activities like cleaning, plantation, surveying, social campaigns, blood donations, health camps etc. They also conducted a successful annual special camp at Khaja Nagar slum area and there our volunteers workers worked with utmost devotion and sincerity and did several welfare work for the poor slum dwellers like eye camp, dental camps, health camps etc.

To look at the achievements of the individual departments, they are working effectively for and all round development of the students. To begin with the Department of **Physics**, Prof Md. Afzal and

his team have got a research project approved, and the project has been sanctioned **thirty lakhs**, and they are exploring the possibilities of production of carbon Nano tubes for water purification of Vijayapur and surrounding area. I'm proud to announce here that both Prof. Md. Afzal and Prof Nadaf have submitted their thesis for PhD award.

Department of **Home Science** every year in the month of Ramzan collect Zakat of about one Lakh from the Muslim rich families and identify the poor destitute uneducated women from slum areas, train them in sewing cloths and purchased sewing machines from that amount and distribute them. Smt. Anis Fatima have under taken research projects sanctioned by U.G.C. They have started a manufacturing unit of producing brown bread with nutritional ingredients. Apart from that the faculties of home Science Smt. Anis Fatima and Prof. Zohra Tabassum Kazi have started a manufacturing unit of producing brown bread with nutritional ingredients. Similarly

Department of Urdu has taken up a project of improving Urdu Language in Urdu Primary School. So they conducted one week training programme for Urdu teachers working in SECAB Association. They also released a book on Urdu fiction of Aman Mazhar.

Department of Mathematics conducted a survey to know the situation of teaching mathematics at Primary and High School run by SECAB Association and they assessed the reasons for backwardness in learning maths.

The **Department of sociology** organized a National Level Seminar sponsored by U.G.C. on 'Female Feticide and its Challenges'.

Department of Kannada is running 'Kannada learning Centre for Non Kannada students of our College and they are training the teacher how to teach Kannada Language.

Department of Economics has many rank holders. They have already started a poor students welfare fund to help poor students Dr. S. M. Hudli, the HOD of the Department has published many articles in peer revied journals

Department of Arabic is also collaborating with Depart of Economics in organizing poor students welfare fund. The Department is also conducting Basic Arabic Classes for Kannada Medium students. Prof. S. M. Mulla is doing research project on 'Calligraphy of Ibrahim Roza'

Department of Commerce though it was established just four years back, it is coming up commendably, and I must congratulate Miss. Bhagya its co-ordinator and all other faculty members who are very young but working with complete dedication to deliver the best. They conducted a Marketing Mela in the last semester and this semester, recently they conducted one day workshop on 'Human Resource Development' by inviting experts from other places I am proud to say here that there are many Commerce Colleges in the city, but ours is the only College which is having commerce stream exclusively in 'English Medium'

Library is fully automated with barcode and SMS services using 'New Genlib' software. library have 27,000 collection worth of rupees more than 32 lakhs. It subscribe online journals from INFLIBNET. Different facilities and services are given like Xerox internet OPAC new arrival display, e-resources. Library is giving special services like wall magazines, CD/DVD programme on regular

intervals, Books review competitions and the library has taken the responsibility of giving minimum level of learning in computer to all the 600 students of College. To inculcate the reading habit among students and for reading and writing a scheme has been started “read a book and get a pen”. Best user award, exhibitions on the eve of Independence and Republic Day. Students are to contributing their own articles, poems and put it in wall magazine. Library initiated the digitizing the documents by using a digital software “D Space” which can access and preserve over the web. All the Institutional repositories like, faculty publications, students projects, College photograph, Question papers, Syllabus, Collection of e-books, News paper clippings, minor research Projects are stored in the Digital Library.
