

Vijayapur City : In terms of history, architecture, traditions and legends, Vijayapur is perhaps the richest district in the state. Evidence show that this city existed since the stone age. Historically, it had been under the rule of Chalukyas (AD-535-758), Rashtrakuta's (AD 757-973), Kalachuri & Hoysala (AD-973-1200), Devagiri Yadava (AD-1185-1312), Khilji rule (1313-1346), Bahamani rule (1347-1489), Adil shahi dynasty (1489-1686), Mughals (1686-1724), Aisf shahi (1724-1760), Marathas (1760-1818), and the British (1818-1947) till independence.

The contribution of these rulers has resulted in the district having many architectural monuments. The city naturally has a cosmopolitan ambiance. The population, though largely made of Kannada speaking Hindus, finds itself living in harmony with other religious, linguistic, ethnic and cultural groups.

In terms of human development index Vijayapur is far behind than other districts in the state, largely because of scanty rains and the lack of focus on development during the last millennia.

About the Association : SECAB is one of the most reputed educational institutions of Vijayapur district. It was established by Mr.S.A.Punekar, a philanthropist and academician of Bijapur in 1969.
